## Background

The COVID-19 pandemic has stopped every single human activity all over the world including Nepal. Now millions of people are affected and are confined to their homes to prevent from the possible outbreak of it. All academic institutions (schools and universities) are closed in Nepal with the government decision of lockdown across the country.

The total number of districts with COVID-19 positive cases has increased to 71 out of 77 with 14 deaths. According to the Ministry of Health, age group of 90 per cent COVID-19 cases ranged from 11 to 50.

On 30 May, the Government of Nepal (GoN) announced an extension to the nationwide lockdown until 14 June 2020. The country lock-down started on 24 March 2020. The flights are suspended until 12 July, 2020.

Due to the extension of the lockdown most of the Nepalese citizens lost their regular economic activities in rural as well as urban areas that increased food crisis among them. Government is providing food package to needy family, but they still lack other sanitation materials. On top of Pandemic Lamjung has to face huge flood in the area.

Considering the situation of extension of lock down and unavailability of job amongst family members, Lion Club of Kathmandu Concern decided to help with sanitation packages to support needy families.

We provided sanitation packages to 116 students of Lamjung districts.

## Sanitation Package Detail:

1. Sanitation package Includes:
  - 6 pieces bath soap
  - 6 pieces of washing soap
  - 2 packets of toothpaste
  - 2 pieces of toothbrush
  - 2 packets of sanitary napkin for girls
  - Towel for boys

**Distribution date:** 26 September 2020

2. We have provided food support to the family of daily wage labor. Food package includes:
  1. 25 Kg Rice
  2. 2 kg Sugar
  3. 2 kg Dal
  4. 2 Kg Salt
  5. 2-liter oil
  6. 4 pieces of Soap
  7. 2 kg beaten rice
